In 2011, a boy diving off the coast of Greece was shocked at the number of plastic bags in the water around him, which he thought outnumbered the fish! Spurred into action by this tragedy in a natural environment he wrote a science paper for his then high school studies. Fast forward to 2013 and he had given up his studies at university to launch a non-profit organisation, The Ocean Cleanup.



Crowdfunded at that time by 38000 people from many countries, the aim was to produce a passive system that gathers large amounts of waste from the ocean. The theory is as impressive as it is simple. Guided by natural currents a large concave boom over 600 metres long and three metres in depth moves more quickly than the materials floating on or near the surface, thus gathering those items in its path.


