Words and usage:	<p>Intrigue</p> <p>Mostly used in the passive form (be intrigued by...), it describes something, perhaps a situation, that we can't understand fully because we lack information. Other similar verbs in the passive form are 'be puzzled by...', 'be mystified by....' or 'be fascinated by...'</p>
