<b>Words and usage:</b>	<p>Become</p> <p>This verb is a special type of verb, a copular verb, which is normally used with adjectives instead of nouns. For example, 'After days of rain, the weather became dry.'</p> <p>Other copular verbs include be, turn, look, seem, appear, go and other verbs to describe feelings such as smell, sound, taste and, of course, feel. Turn can be used for both copular and regular verbs, as in 'I turned the corner and walked along the road.'</p>
